### Miss Katie



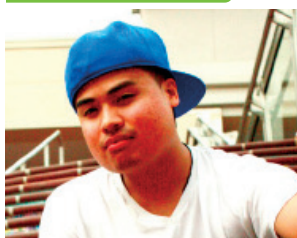
